MINUTES January 10th, 2021 6:00 p.m.

CALL TO ORDER

- 1) Quorum – Parliamentarian: 16 voting members present
- 2) Call to Order: 6:04 PM.
- 3) CONSENT CALENDAR: Cork made a motion to approve the consent calendar. Linda seconded. Motion passed.

- 5) Visitor Introductions:
 - Jim Wisely: Volunteer with the CDP voter services committee. He helps find candidates in rural districts to run against Republicans and offers financial assistance. He suggested getting people to run on a single issue as a way to educate the public, and cause Republicans to have to defend the seat.
- 6) IN MEMORIAM - DCCSC Member Debbie Israel passed away on December 24, 2021. Debbie was a valued and experienced member of our team whose vast knowledge and dedication to the cause will be sorely missed. A tribute to Debbie is planned for our website.

 - a. New Year's video Message from Senator Alex Padilla
 - b. Redistricting Update: Cork & Cheryl- Max Steiner described the new CD1 district. It goes from 58% Republican to about 60% Republican, and an increase in minority voters. Cheryl talked about the new Shasta county supervisorial districts. Max talked about AD1 and SD1 which remain as competitive as before.

8) OLD BUSINESS

- a. Recall Election Feb 1 - District 2: Update from Cheryl - Individual members of the committee volunteered to help Moty walking precincts, phone banking, and sending postcards.

9) REPORTS OF STANDING COMMITTEES: (2-minute time limit and/or written report)

- a. Finance - Lisa Cole- Total for both accounts is 3136.54. This is a decrease of \$52.17 from last month's total. Jenny reported on fines from 2 years ago that were levied by the Secretary of State after a previous treasurer failed to file required reports electronically. A first waiver request to the state was denied, but after a second waiver request the liability was cut in half. Jenny will set up a payment plan in order to pay the fines, which total a little over \$5000.
- b. Fundraising- Sarah Casia- There will be an online fundraising event similar to Shastapalooza on March 20th. An online fundraising campaign officially kicked off in December. About \$126 has been raised through the newsletters and Facebook posts. She asked that people share DCCSC fundraising posts on Facebook.
- c. Media - Madison Zimmerman- The media committee is focusing on collaboration with other committees with the goal of generating more original content. They are still looking for a photographer. Anyone who takes pictures at DCCSC events should send them to Madison.
- d. Elections - Elizabeth Betancourt- The Chamber of Commerce reached out to Jenny about the DCCSC participating in a candidate training workshop on January 22nd. She will put together a presentation but not attend in person because of COVID concerns. The elections committee has postponed its candidate recruitment event.
- e. Bylaws - Will Pasley- Still working on the bylaws.
